

I. OUR FATHER WHICH ART IN HEAVEN, HALLOWED BE THY NAME

- A. Make your first act of prayer a worship to God for all He is and recognize your relationship with Him as Father.
- B. Worship God for who He is by recognizing the names used to identify His character in the Old Testament scriptures.
(REFER TO PRAYER GUIDE SUPPLEMENT)
- C. All of mankind has a problem with sin, but God provides victory over sin and its power. God brings freedom to those who receive Him, and the Bible shows us that we can have a personal relationship with God.

II. THY KINGDOM COME. THY WILL BE DONE.

- A. Yourself – I lay my life down and make Your will my greatest aim.
- B. Your Family – Lift them up by name.
- C. Your Church – Set yourself in agreement with the vision and for God's provision and resources to be abundant. (people, finances, spiritual power, wisdom)
 - 1. Leadership – unified, spirit-led, empowered
 - 2. Body – willing, unified, dedicated, generous
 - 3. Volunteers – strengthened, blessed, refreshed, restored and plentiful
- D. Government
 - 1. Local – city council, library boards, school boards
 - 2. State – governor, Senate and House, all levels
 - 3. National – president, Congress, all areas
- E. Education Systems – God-honoring, children protected, godly teachers strengthened
- F. Media – Pray for effective ways to communicate truth and produce unity

III. GIVE US THIS DAY OUR DAILY BREAD

- A. Nourishment for your soul
 - 1. Mind, will and emotions
- B. Read scripture
- C. Pray for revelation
- D. Ask God to reveal it
- E. Meditate on that Word He reveals
- F. Praise Him and thank Him for His daily provision

Lord, show me Your will concerning all areas of life. Lord give me peace of mind regardless of my circumstances. God, enable me to be Spirit-led, not emotionally directed. I will be obedient to your Word today and always.

IV. FORGIVE US OUR TRESPASSES AS WE FORGIVE THOSE WHO TRESPASS AGAINST US

- A. Repent of any sin and ask Him to forgive you and receive His forgiveness.
- B. Release others from wrong the way God has released you.
- C. Declare with your mouth "I am forgiven and free. I choose to forgive myself, as well as others. Therefore, I carry no shame or bitterness and am free in Jesus name."

V. AND LEAD US NOT INTO TEMPTATION, BUT DELIVER US FROM EVIL

- A. Ephesians 6:10-18 tells us to be ready to fight against the evil forces of Satan and not human forces.
 - 1. Verse 10 declares we are to be strong in the Lord and His mighty power.
 - 2. Verse 11 says to put on His armor so we can stand against the strategies of the devil.
 - 3. Verse 14 – Take your stand with the belt of truth and the body armor of God's righteousness.
 - 4. Verse 15 – For our feet will go in God's peace and be fully prepared because of the Good News of the gospel.
 - 5. Verse 16 – Hold up the shield of faith to stop the fiery arrows of the devil.
 - 6. Verse 17 – put on the helmet of salvation and take the sword of the spirit, which is the Word of God.
 - 7. Verse 18 – Pray with the help of the Holy Spirit continually and on every occasion.
- B. Psalms 91 tells us to pray a hedge of protection around our family, house, church, etc.

VI. FOR YOURS IS THE KINGDOM, THE POWER AND THE GLORY FOREVER

- A. Set your faith that you will not draw back, but walk by faith, not by sight!
- B. In setting your faith, with praise and thanksgiving to God, give God praise for what ***He has done, is doing now and is going to do!***
